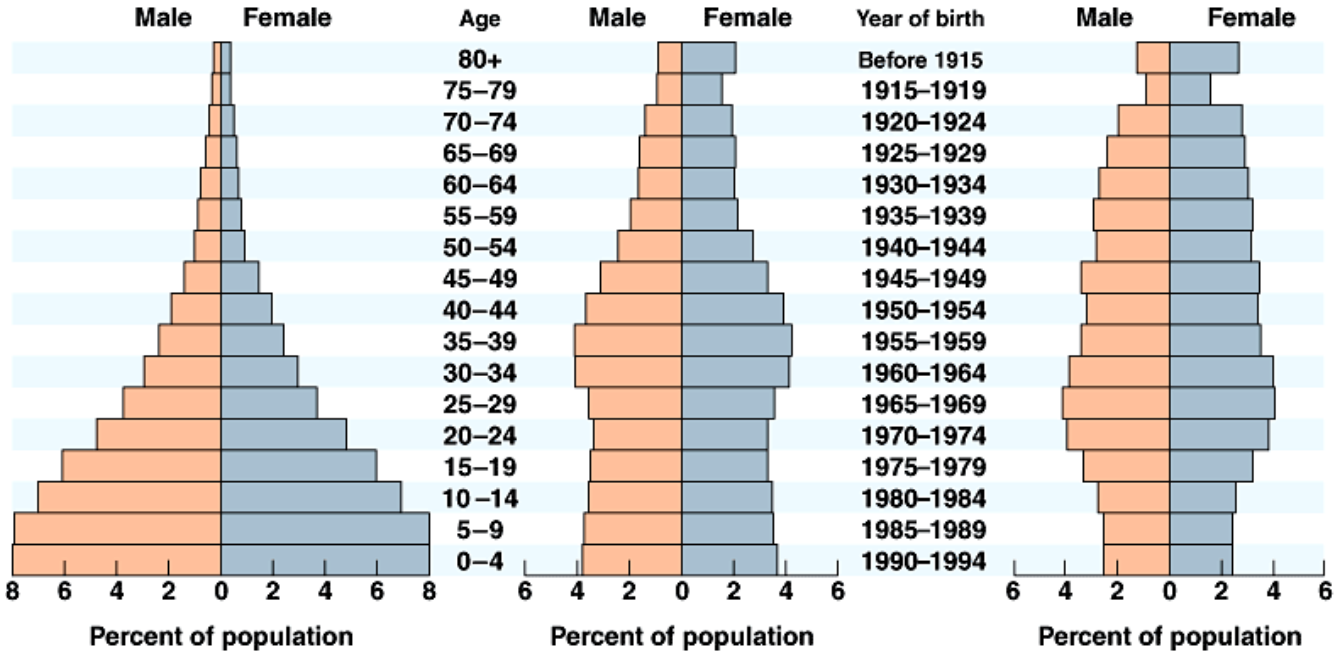

| <p>Characteristics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • high birth rate • high death rate • short life expectancy • large families • increasing growth rate <p>Issues/Concerns:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Many workers to support the needs of the elderly <p>High Demand For:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • schools/education • medical services (pediatric) • high employment | <p>Characteristics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • constant birth rate • low death rate • long life expectancy • smaller families • decreasing growth rate <p>Issues/Concerns:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Less</u> workers to support the needs of the elderly <p>High Demand For:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • medical services (geriatric) • high competition for jobs between the young (20-35) and older workers (40-55) <p>(US Debt Clock)</p> | <p>Characteristics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>low</u> birth rate • low death rate • long life expectancy • smaller families • decreasing growth rate <p>Issues/Concerns:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Few</u> workers to support the needs of the elderly <p>High Demand For:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • medical services (geriatric) <p>(Japan Article)</p> |
